



Black circles (symbolize black stones in the floor picture):

Cut out 2 circles as a template for the black circles. Place them on a black sheet of paper, overlapping as in the picture. Then cut the whole thing out. Fold it where it overlaps (hint: It looks like a clam.)

Cut out the yellow circles of the previous page and stick them inside. The yellow paper is peeking out a little bit - so the viewer gets a hunch that there's something within the black circle. If the viewer opens it, they can read God's promise.

Outside on the black circle,
write the following. One
